We process personal data based on:

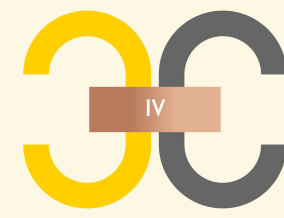
- Performance of a contract
